RECOMMENDATIONS BEFORE INSTALLATION

- Reset all car radio audio settings:
 - Ambience = Natural
 - Bass / Midrange / Treble settings = 0
 - Loudness = OFF
 - Fader and Balance = Centred
- The speaker drivers require a break-in period (approximately 20 hours) before they reach optimal sound quality.
 - After this break-in period, you can fine-tune the audio settings as you please.



I. ASSEMBLING THE FRONT SPEAKER DRIVERS

1. Equipment required for assembling the woofer.

2. Connections

Note:

the crossover (with the black shielding) can be mounted any way around.

3. Assemble the speaker driver with the spacer

Note:

It is recommended to glue the crossover on the woofer



4. Screw the speaker driver into its support

Note:

Run the cable in the adequate notch



II. INSTALLING THE FRONT SPEAKER DRIVERS

The picture below shows the location of the screws to remove.



1. Unclip the door panels using prying tools.

3. Use some adhesive tape behind the rivets to ensure they don't fall into the car door and remove them



4. Fix the speaker driver using the supplied rivets and a large crimping tool





Note: Rivets are large but smooth to avoid any vibrations of the speaker drivers




III. ASSEMBLING THE TWEETERS

1. Equipment required for assembling the tweeter.



2. Remove the grille by simply unclipping it.





III. ASSEMBLING THE TWEETERS

3. Slot the tweeter into the spacer making sure it's the right way up.

Note:


Slot the wires into the same side the 2 tabs are fixed to.



4. Connect at position 2

Note:

position 1 is not used in this set-up.

IV. INSTALLING THE TWEETERS



1. Remove the tweeter grille (from inside to outside)



2.a. If there's an original tweeter, remove it (by simply unclipping it)





2.b. If there is no original tweeter, remove the pre-cut part with a screwdriver, and remove the support to free the connector



IV. INSTALLING THE TWEETERS



3. Connect the tweeter



4. Insert the crossover into compartment tilting it forward



5. Clips the tweeter into its compartment




6. Stick the supplied logo on the grille

1. To access the rear speaker driver platine: remove the seat and filp the backrest forward

2. Remove the support from its compartment



3. Screw the rivets to remove the speaker driver



4. Rivet on the support and fix it in the car, the tweeter is rotary and has to be oriented upwards

Before reinstalling the right side panel, run the subwoofer connector



VII. PREPARING THE SUBWOOFER

1. Glue the two strips of hook-and-loop fasteners as shown.

Note:

be careful not to cover up the serial number.




2. Connect the extension cable to the head unit - subwoofer interconnect cable.




Note:

the adapter can only be used on an original head unit



3. Cut off the terminal and splice.









The ground cable has to be connected to the ground connector located near the rear light



Auto Power = ON Phase = 0°



- 1. Run the power connector + interconnect cable + remote control cable from the subwoofer to the head unit.
- **2. Remove the glove box** to run the connector to the head unit









3. Remove the superior venting grid for a better head unit connector accessibility



4. Connect the power connector to the 12V power socket.







5. Remove the head unit and connect to the connectors
