
RECOMMENDATIONS BEFORE INSTALLATION

- Reset all car radio audio settings:
 - Ambience = Natural
 - Bass / Midrange / Treble settings = 0
 - Loudness = OFF
 - Fader and Balance = Centred
- The speaker drivers require a break-in period (approximately 20 hours) before they reach optimal sound quality.
- After this break-in period, you can fine-tune the audio settings as you please.

Fasten the crossover in place using a cable tie.


Note:

1. Equipment required for assembling the tweeter.


2. Remove the grille by simply unclipping it.








Template to cut out for the **left tweeter**:





Template to cut out for the **right tweeter**:






1. Remove the trim



2. Glue the template (see pages 9 & 10) on the basis of the trim and mark the holes locations for the screws






3. Drill the trim and fix the support







4. Place the tweeter, use the key to fix it with a quarter turn counterclockwise **and push the grille back**



5. Push the trim back





1. Wiring required for the tweeter connection



Note:

Be careful to apply the correct fitting orientation (right/left) during the wiring installation in the vehicle.



2. Remove the head unit











3. Remove the side covers using prying tools.





4. Remove the rug above the glove box to facilitate the wires running.







5. Run the cable behind the dashboard and the glove box then get it out through the windshield pillar









6. Then connect the tweeters behind the head unit using the provided wiring








VI. PREPARING THE SUBWOOFER

Equipment required for installing the subwoofer:



Head unit – subwoofer interconnect cable (e.g. Velcro)

VI. PREPARING THE SUBWOOFER

1. Glue the two strips of hook-and-loop fasteners as shown.

Note:

be careful not to cover up the serial number.




2. Connect the extension cable to the head unit subwoofer interconnect cable.

the adapter can only be used on an original head unit



3. Cut off the terminal and splice.




VII. POSITIONING AND ADJUSTING THE SUBWOOFER





Note: The subwoofer is positionned under the centre passenger seat.



Auto Power = ON Phase = 0°



1. Unclip and remove the lateral panels, then the passengers seats







2. Make a Ø2 cm hole in the carpet












3. Connect the subwoofer cable bundle to the head unit






4. Run the power connector + interconnect cable from the subwoofer to the head unit through the door, then under the carpet down to the hole








5. Connect the power connector to the 12V power socket
