


RECOMMENDATIONS BEFORE INSTALLATION


- Reset all car radio audio settings:
 - Ambience = Natural
 - Bass / Midrange / Treble settings = 0
 - Loudness = OFF
 - Fader and Balance = Centred
- The speaker drivers require a break-in period (approximately 20 hours) before they reach optimal sound quality.

After this break-in period, you can fine-tune the audio settings as you please.












2. Connections

Note:

the crossover (with the black shielding) can be mounted any way around.





Fasten the crossover in place using a cable tie. Note:

the cable tie mustn't come into contact with the spider (yellow part) when the speaker driver is in motion.

1. Remove the console and the connectors, then unscrew the screw




IV. ASSEMBLING THE TWEETERS

2. Remove the grille by simply unclipping it.


3. Slot the tweeter into the spacer making sure it's the right way up.

Note: *slot the wires into the same side the 2 tabs are fixed to.*


1. Remove the tweeter cover and disconnect it



VIII. PREPARING THE SUBWOOFER

1. Glue the two strips of hook-and-loop fasteners as shown.

Note:

be careful not to cover up the serial number.



2. Connect the extension cable to the head unit - subwoofer interconnect cable.



the adapter can only be used on an original head unit

Already used during the installation of Live kit on vehicles which are not equipped with original tweeter cables








3. Cut off the terminal and splice.



IX. POSITIONING AND ADJUSTING THE SUBWOOFER

1. Position the subwoofer under the trunk's floor




Phase = 180, this depends on many parameters, so it advisable to try both positions without altering any other settings, and then to choose the one which sounds best.

2. Connect the power supply (red cable), the speakers and the ground cable (black cable)






3. Remove the four clips from the panel and then connect the ground cable to the screw







4. After connecting the filter and the speaker extension to the Subwoofer, run the wiring through the trunk corner under the seat retainer bar






2.a Remove the central console



2.b Turn the ring a quarter turn to remove the













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3. Unscrew the two screws on each side of the back of the console





4. Remove the cover under the parking brake and remove the bracket








5. Run the wiring along the existing wiring by attaching it with collars and then run it under the carpet to the gear knob along the handbrake





6. Remove the cover from the glove compartment then the two studs








7. Remove the cover above the glove compartment and then the glove compartment








8. Plug the white plug of the Focal connector into the top plug of the car stereo and then connect the car radio wiring to the white plug of the Focal connector





9. Install the wiring between the seats at the center console location





10. Connect the power adapter to the power cable of the subwoofer and to power socket
